

Immigration Status

International Students must comply with Argentine immigration regulations.

- **Special Transitory Residence. Extra MERCOSUR,**

Student visa is not required before leaving your country.

(Residencia Transitoria Especial)

If you are natural of one of the following countries you must apply for a **Special Transitory Residence at Dirección Nacional de Migraciones** (Av. Antártida Argentina 1355 Buenos Aires) within 30 days from your registration at **Universidad de Belgrano**.

For a one-semester exchange (up to 6 months), you'll need:

- *Your Passport (original)*
- *A full copy of your passport*
- *2 photographs 4cm x 4cm square, against a blue background, full face*

- *Registration certificate issued by Universidad de Belgrano (the length of your courses must be shown!)*
- *Criminal Records Certificate. This certificate should be issued in Argentina, at Dirección Nacional del Registro Nacional de Reincidencia (Piedras 115 - Buenos Aires). It costs \$ 27,50 (twenty-seven pesos with 50/100). There are other more expensive options if you want to obtain the certificate faster.*
- *Immigration Tax \$300 (three hundred pesos)*

For a two-semester exchange (up to 12 months), you'll need:

- *Your Passport (original)*
- *A full copy of your passport*
- *2 photographs 4cm x 4cm square, against a blue background, full face*
- *Registration certificate issued by Universidad de Belgrano (the length of your courses must be shown!)*
- *Criminal Records Certificate. You must bring this certificate from your country of residence or from the countries where you have lived in the last five years. It must be legalized by the Argentine consulate or it must be certified with the Apostille of The Hague.*
- *Criminal Records Certificate (in Argentina). This certificate should be issued in Argentina, at Dirección Nacional del Registro Nacional de Reincidencia (Piedras 115 Buenos Aires). It costs \$ 27,50 (twenty seven pesos with 50/100) There are other more expensive options if you want to obtain the certificate faster.*
- *Immigration Tax \$300 (three hundreds pesos)*
